



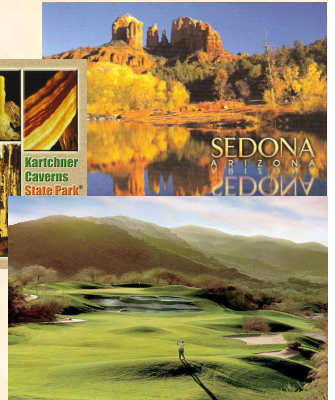
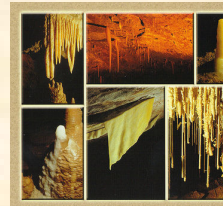
2012 SACC National Convention January 15-17 Fountain Hills, AZ

The highlight of being in the Phoenix area this time of year, aside from the 66 degree average temperature, will be the 41st Annual Barrett-Jackson Collector Car Auction in Scottsdale, AZ. We have planned our event to coincide with the start of the auction, allowing you to maximize your convention & vacation travel dollars. Come early and stay late to take in all that Arizona, the greater Phoenix Area, and the auction have to offer.

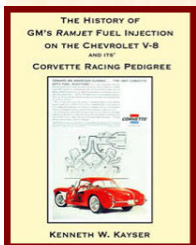


The Holiday Inn & Resort in Fountain Hills will be our host hotel. It is an intimate hotel located in the heart of Fountain Hills, and just across from the famous Fountain Hills fountain. The fountain was built in 1970 by Robert P. McCulloch (who also constructed the London Bridge in Lake Havasu City), and for a decade was the world's tallest Fountain (it is now 4th tallest). Fountain Hills borders the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community and Scottsdale, AZ.

There is much to do in and around Fountain Hills,. There are several golf courses, and the Fort McDowell Casino is right around the corner for when you are "feeling lucky." Downtown Scottsdale is home to lots of shopping and fine dining, and of course the Barrett-Jackson Auction. If you want to extend your stay but are not interested in the auction, then across Arizona, and within a day driving distance, there is Flagstaff (skiing), the Grand Canyon (yup- big hole in the ground), Sedona (shopping, sight seeing), Benson (Kartchner Caverns), and of course downtown Phoenix (golfing, shows, sporting events).



Now for the 2012 Convention. Arrival day is Sunday, January 15th. For those who arrive early, you are welcome to join us at CRUIZ'N @ PHIL'S, a local car show just down the road from the hotel at Phil's Filling Station Grill (starts at 12pm). At 6pm that evening we will have our opening reception at the host hotel, where you can sit back, relax, and meet new friends and catch up with old friends.



On Monday morning we'll start off with a tech session featuring Ken Kayser and will include a box lunch. For the ladies (and men) there will be organized activities to go shopping in Scottsdale or take a cruise on Saguaro Lake (lunch on your own for both activities). Monday night there will be a unique and memorable Vettes & Planes dinner event taking place at the Commemorative Air Force Museum (www.azcaf.com). Aviation from a bygone era is brought to life before your eyes.

The collection of World War II, Korea and Vietnam aircraft, friend and foe alike, ranges from the early trainer, to fast medium bombers to heavy bombers. And you won't want to miss being up close to the beautiful B-17G Flying Fortress—Sentimental Journey (pictured at right).



Tuesday morning we start off early for a road tour/lunch out to Tortilla Flats: an authentic remnant of an old west town. Along the way you will enjoy some great desert landscapes and a stop at the Superstition Mountain Museum where you can learn about and see artifacts, history and folklore of the Superstition Mountains and surrounding area. We end our activities on Tuesday evening with a Reception and Banquet at the beautiful Sunridge Golf resort.

The host hotel rate will be \$159 (plus tax), and will include breakfast each morning. This is a great rate for hotels around the area during the time of the year.
